## The Dialectics of Social Cognition: An Enactive Account of Labour

**Chair**: **Tommaso Guariento**, postdoc ERC project AIMODELS

Enactive approach in cognitive science can help understanding the complexity of social cognition. The main argument is that this requires also integrating dialectical tools into the perspective of the embodied mind. Individualist models of cognition are challenged for failing to account for the inherently social and interactive nature of cognitive processes. Labour is analysed as an exemplary case of socially distributed and ecologically extended cognition.
