How to Follow the Fact of Human Beings and Herd the Masses —Han Fei Zi's View of Human Nature Dr. **Tongdong Bai** is the Dongfang Chair Professor of Philosophy at Fudan University in China, and a member of the Pontifical Academy of Social Sciences. His research interests include Chinese philosophy and political philosophy. He has two books published in English: China: The Political Philosophy of the Middle Kingdom (Zed Books, 2012), and Against Political Equality: The Confucian Case (Princeton University Press, 2019). He is now working on the philosophy of Han Fei Zi (c. 280-233 BCE), a "Legalist" and a harsh critic of Confucians, as well as a real-life princeling who is often compared with Machiavelli and

Hobbes. He is also the director of an Englishbased MA and visiting program in Chinese philosophy at Fudan University that is intended to promote the studies of Chinese philosophy in the world.
