Deadlines for Applications

- The deadline for scholarship applications dedicated to developing countries students is the 5th of March, 2024. Applicants admitted to the grant will be informed via e-mail by the 15th of March 2024. Number of scholarships available: 15.
- The deadline for applications for on-site participation (Paying student) is the 15th of May, 2024. Registration fee: 850 € (VAT included); this includes full week classes, accommodation in Venice, breakfasts, coffee breaks, and lunches. 450 € (VAT included) for attendees without accommodation.
- The deadline for applications for on-line participation (Paying students) is the 18th of June,
 2024. Registration fee: 170 € (VAT included); this includes full week classes online classes in live streaming, and access to the material of the school.

Payment deadlines

- Once accepted to participate to the school on-site, the fee payment should be made by 25th
 May, 2024.
- Once accepted to participate to the school on-line, the fee payment should be made by 18th of June, 2024.
