What is included in the Young Ambassadors Programme?

The programme includes:

- **E-learning** journey, to acquire a deep understanding of the Michelangelo Foundation, the Homo Faber 2024 theme and the exhibited crafts;
- **Webinars**, to develop communication skills;
- One-week onsite training in Venice to get to know the Young Ambassadors community, immerse into the Homo Faber 2024 premises and further develop communication skills;
- Travel arrangements;
- **Accommodation** and **meals** (breakfast + lunch) during the whole duration of the event:
- **Grant**, consisting of a flat rate to cover dinners and a stipend for general expenses during the 6-week stay in Venice;
- Full support on administrative and training aspects.
- Is the Young Ambassadors Programme depending on local sponsors, as the Homo Faber Fellowship?

The programme is co-financed by several sponsors, that are not necessarily local sponsors as for the Homo Faber Fellowship.

• Can students who have participated to the 2018 <u>and</u> 2022 edition of the Young Ambassadors Programme apply for a third time?

Unfortunately, we will only consider candidates who have participated to a maximum of one previous edition.

 Because of the teaching calendar in our school/university, our students are not able to commit to the Young Ambassadors Programme. Can we still promote the programme to our recent graduates?

Yes, as we will consider applications from recent graduates.

Please note that depending on their studies (craft-oriented or not), recent graduates might be more interested in the Homo Faber Fellowship.

• Can students enrolled in a Design degree apply to the Young Ambassadors Programme?

Yes, as the audience we are targeting are creative students from applied arts, design or another creative field.

• Is the level of Italian an eliminatory criterion?

Since Homo Faber Biennial is taking place in Venice, Italy, it is compulsory for all participants to be able to understand and speak some Italian (A2 level). Applicants will be tested on their level of Italian during the interview process.
