Jacob Shores-Argüello is a Costa Rican American poet and prose writer. He is the author of In the Absence of Clocks, which was awarded the 2011 Crab Orchard Series Open Competition, judged by Yusef Komunyakaa. Jacob is the recipient of a Fulbright Fellowship, the Dzanc Books ILP International Literature Award. the Fine Arts Work Center Fellowship in Provincetown, the Djerassi Resident Artist's Fellowship, and the Amy Clampitt residency in Lenox, MA. His second book Paraíso was selected for the inaugural CantoMundo Poetry Prize judged by Aracelis Girmay. He is a 2018/2019 Hodder Fellow at Princeton University, a Lannan Literary Fellow for Poetry, and a 2024-2025 Rome Prize winner in Literature.

His poetry appears in "The New Yorker", "Poetry Magazine", and "The Academy of American Poets", among others.
